#### Valley View Schools Eichelberg and Ireland Scholarship

Plan to major in the arts, music or theater | Be accepted to attend a two- or four-year college or university

#### Valley View Schools Dursch-Jackson Scholarship

Be accepted to a two- or four-year accredited institution of higher education | Demonstrate financial need | Have not received any other major scholarships | Demonstrate an active role in high school including community and extracurricular activities | Preference will be given to students with an excellent attendance record

#### Doug Riley Scholarship

Be accepted to a two- or four-year accredited institution of higher education | Have lettered in at least one Varsity level sport | Have demonstrated outstanding sportsmanship qualities | Demonstrate involvement in school and community activities | Demonstrate a strong school attendance record

#### Steven R. and Heather M. Anderson Scholarship

Demonstrate the ability to succeed academically | Be accepted to attend a two- or four-year accredited college or university | Be actively involved in school and/or community activities | Reflect the Anderson's strong values of leadership, character, and honesty | Demonstrate good attendance

#### Knights of Pythias Scholarship

Be accepted to a two- or four-year accredited college or university | Demonstrate outstanding academic ability through high school grades, standardized test scores and teacher recommendations | Demonstrate financial need

#### Muse Machine Carrie Vanderbeek Scholarship

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial support to further the education of a student within the Valley View School District who shares Carrie's great love and enthusiasm for the fine and performing arts. The scholarship shall support higher education for students who plan to major or minor in fine or performing arts. It will be based on the student's ability to succeed academically and an evaluation of their activities in the fine or performing arts. Fine and performing arts shall be defined as, but not limited to: painting, drawing, photography, sculpture, creative writing, architecture, film studies, music, dance, drama and technical theatre. If the recipient does not attend school within one year of being awarded the scholarship, he/she will forfeit the scholarship unless the one-year delay is due to sickness or disability. In the event that the recipient should receive a full scholarship or its equivalent from another source, the scholarship will be granted to another deserving student. The recipient must continue to major or minor in the fine and/or performing arts (see below) in order to continue receiving the scholarship.

## **Valley View Athletic Booster Scholarship**

Minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale | Minimum of two varsity letters: at least one must be earned during senior year | Consistently demonstrate leadership, character and attitude in the community, school and on the field | Student-athletes that receive an Athletic scholarship to either a DI or DII university/college are not permitted to apply

## **VVBASE Baseball and Softball Scholarship**

Have a minimum 2.5 GPA | Be accepted to attend a two- or four-year accredited college or university or a technical college | Play baseball or softball his/her senior year

## **Dean and Jeanine Stiver Community Kindness Scholarship**

Be accepted to an accredited two-year, four-year, technical school or college or university | Have successful experience being employed or volunteering/community services | Financial need will be considered if all else is equal | Identify as LGBTQ+ or be an ally | To foster a positive image of LGBTQ+ people and their allies, applicants should be involved in at least one of the following: Be actively involved in a campus or community based LGBTQ+ or related organization. Be a volunteer in LGBTQ+ or AIDS/HIV organization or be an advocate on issues related to LGBTQ+ people.
