

Daily Home Screening for Valley View Students

Parents: Please complete this short **checklist** each morning before your child leaves for school.

SECTION 1: Symptoms

If a student answers YES to any questions in Section 1 the student MUST stay home and parents should contact their healthcare provider for further guidance. If a student answers YES to any questions in section 1 and NO to all questions in Section 2, he/she may return to school when symptom-free and fever-free for 24 hours without fever reducing medications.

(1)	Fever, fatigue, muscle or body aches
(2)	Sore throat, loss of taste or smell
(3)	Cough, runny nose
(4)	Diarrhea, vomiting, abdominal pain
(5)	Headache

SECTION 2: Close Contact/Potential Exposure

(6)	Had close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with a person with confirmed COVID-19 **MUST QUARANTINE 14 DAYS & NOTIFY SCHOOL NURSE**
(7)	Traveled to a state where the local or state health department is reporting numbers of COVID-19 positivity rates greater than 15%. See Ohio DOH COVID-19 Travel Advisory listing.
(8)	Live in areas of very high exposure and spread (Montgomery County Level 3 or 4) as described in the Ohio COVID-19 Risk Level Guidelines for the Public, while school remains open.

If a student answers YES to any questions in Section 1, PLUS yes to any questions in Section 2, a diagnosis of ill symptoms is required by a healthcare provider before return to school is permitted. Please notify school nurse of results.

If a student is diagnosed with COVID-19 he/she may return to school after 10 days of isolation at home and is symptom-free and fever-free for 24 hours without fever reducing medications. **Must notify office or school nurse at time of diagnosis.**

If YES answers are only for questions 7 or 8, please monitor for symptoms. Isolation or quarantine is not needed and student may attend school.
